


Mashal Model School

About Mashal Model School

Established in 2008, Mashal is a not-for-profit organization and registered trust with the Private Institution Educational Regulatory Authority (PIERA). We adopt a community-based approach, operating branches in Bari Imam, H-9/2 Akram Colony, Islamabad, and Hargisa, Skardu, Gilgit-Baltistan. Currently, we serve 900 children aged 3 to 21.

Since 2011, skill development has been a major component of our work. To date, 780 children have been mainstreamed into government schools, 470 have passed matriculation examinations and entered the workforce, and 70 are pursuing higher studies. Formal Education:

Alternative Learning Programs (ALP) and Packages A, B, C, D, E by Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) and Allama Iqbal Open University.





Middle Tech:

We offer courses in beauty and graphic design, with 40 girls completing an 18-month program after dropping out after class 8.

Speed Literacy Program

In collaboration with Vision 21 Foundation, this initiative aims to achieve primary-level literacy for non-literate children within one year and matriculation-level literacy in three to four years. Students are referred to this program after Grade 8 for higher examination scores.



Right to Play:

We have been partnering with Right to Play (RTP) since 2010, implementing their educational modules in our classes.



Volunteerism:

Volunteerism is vital to our success as change agents. We engage with organizations like the Pakistan Red Crescent Society, Girl Guides, child protection agencies, and community policing efforts. Collaborations include Shield, Shifa Community Services, Riphah, NUST, FAST, SZABIST, LUMUN, Roots, Islamabad Preparatory School, and Special Needs.



Financial Accountability:

Our financial records are maintained by certified accountants and undergo annual audits to ensure transparency.



Teachers:

Mashal School employs 50 teachers across three branches, 43 of whom are female. They are committed to promoting literacy, with three annual teacher training workshops focusing on capacity building.



Sustainability:

We collaborate with individual donors and organizations to ensure our financial sustainability.
